The University of Iowa School of Art & Art History offers Spotlight grants to support innovation in the creation of visual art. The goals of the Spotlight Program are the artistic development of individual students and the enhancement of students' portfolios. The work completed will be exhibited in the annual Spotlight Exhibition. Ten awards of up to \$600, will be granted annually. Allowable expenditures from the award include, but are not limited to, art supplies, modeling, and framing.

The Spotlight Program is made possible by a generous gift from Donna Friedman Curry.

All awardees will display their work at a year-end exhibition, hosted by the School of Art and Art History. Recipients of the Spotlight Grant are expected to provide a short write-up describing what they have accomplished with the award. A brochure with each participant's written statement will be prepared by the school prior to the exhibition.

Your proposal should include an introduction, outline, and description of your project. Your identified faculty advisor will also need to sign off on your application materials (see more details regarding a faculty advisor below).
