### **REGISTRATION:**

**Minor restriction:** Nov. 16- last day of early registration for majors. On Nov. 16 the registration will change to include majors and minors. Informatic cognate can submit special permission requests at that time.

**WAITLISTS:** If you are unable to get into a class because it is closed, please get on the waitlist. We cannot consider opening new sections unless we have the numbers to back up interest and enrollment.

**HOLDS ON REGISTRATION:** I have gotten emails from several of you about not being able to register because of a student agreement hold. If you have one of these you need to go into your MyUI, under courses and registration, for the spring 2019, you will need to pull up the student agreement form and click I agree.
